I was reading something during the week about a world-famous leader who was reflecting on his life – I won't mention who it was in case there would be political disagreements. One of the interesting things he said was that he had to remember to "see people". He had to teach himself to "see" and acknowledge the person who opened his chauffeured driven car. He had to "see" the person who served him in the restaurant or the person who worked in his house. I thought it was an interesting observation. It can be so easy not to "see" people, to take people for granted. We may be so taken up with what we think is important that we may not "see" people who do so much for us – the person at the supermarket checkout, the person who serves us in a restaurant, the person who cleans up after us, the person who drives the bus. We can be so preoccupied we may not even acknowledge these people. And yet it is so important for everyone's dignity that we acknowledge and show respect for all.
