Pastor's Ponderings

I was reading something during the week and it said that almost half of all art in the world is based on the Christian story and the message of Jesus Christ. Certainly when you look at European art and the world of the Renaissance, an immense amount of painting is based on the person of Jesus and Mary, the mother of God. Jesus died the death of a nobody in Palestine two thousand years ago and yet he is probably the most famous person who ever lived on planet earth. I enjoy looking at art. Some art I don't always understand. But even that pushes me and challenges me. It's interesting that you have to stand at the right distance to look at a painting. If you stand too far away, you can't see the detail correctly. If you stand too close, you see too much detail and the brushstrokes which were never intended to be seen. You have to stand at the correct distance and have the right perspective. And life is a bit like that too. Sometimes when something happens we seem to get annoyed about little things. We lose our sense of the broader picture and what is important in life. So, let's take an opportunity to stand back, gain perspective and see things in their context. Then we'll have a better attitude and we may become wise! (Fr. George Hayes)
