<u>Geptember 8th is the Feast of the</u> <u>Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary</u>

The Feast of the Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated exactly nine months after the

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, just as Christmas is celebrated nine months after the Church remembers the Incarnation of the Son of God on the Solemnity of the Annunciation. The birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of three liturgical feasts in which we celebrate a birth: Christmas, the Birth of Saint John the Baptist, and the Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Only the three most consequential figures in the Bible receive the honour of a liturgical celebration to commemorate their births.
