**New regulations from the Irish Episcopal Conference introduced on Nov 28<sup>th</sup> 2016 state that freedom to marry has to be established in the new Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Forms before the wedding booking can be confirmed.**

**This is to be filled out by the Priest of the Parish where you are living:**

- I have established that this person is free to marry in the Catholic Church (and if they had been married by Church or State in the past I have approached my Bishop/Diocesan Office to establish their freedom to marry)
- I have filled out Section A of the Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Form on 'Establishing the Freedom to Marry', having gathered the necessary documentation, and am satisfied that this person is free to marry.
- I hope to meet this person again approximately 2/3 months before the wedding to complete the remainder of the Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Form and will then post it onto Kenmare Parish.
