Pastor's Ponderings

There's an air of Spring about the place. St. Brigid, that great woman of faith and courage, is celebrated on February 1st and we in Ireland celebrate the beginning of Spring. Internationally, the meteorologists tell us that Spring begins on March 1st. However, we keep the ancient Irish tradition and declare Spring has begun. You can see growth emerging in the bulbs. Snowdrops have appeared and daffodils are beginning to show their yellow heads. Soon there will be new lambs in the fields and farmers with cows will be busy feeding new calves as they are born. I always think nature has so much to teach us about life. We have our times of winter and times of spring, times of summer and times of autumn. And isn't life like that too? We can experience the dying of autumn or the cold of winter. And in our lives, there are the summer days, when life is easy and the living is good. And spring days are about new adventures, new opportunities, new growth. Do a little check and see how you are feeling about life today – do you have a sense of spring, summer, autumn or winter? I'm always amazed about the certainty of spring - no matter how cold and windswept winter has been, no matter how much snow has been on the ground and how much frost there has been, with the coming of spring, we herald new life - the bulbs push up new shoots and new life emerges. In these days of early Spring, go out into nature. Try to see where new growth is emerging. And know that new growth is possible in your life. And in my life.
