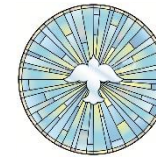
The feast of Pentecost has a special sequence that is a beautiful work of prayer.

On various feasts throughout the year, the Church has a tradition to recite or sing a special "sequence." On Pentecost, the sequence is entitled **Veni, Sancte Spiritus** and invokes the Holy Spirit, asking for the Spirit to come and refresh our weary hearts. The sequence dates back to at least the 13th century and has been used in the liturgy on the feast of Pentecost ever since. While often these hymns can go by quickly during the liturgy, in truth these are prayers and can be prayed privately as well, opening our hearts to the dwelling of the Spirit.



A Prayer for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Lord Jesus Christ
Send down your spirit upon me.
When I am uncertain, grant me wisdom
When I am confused, grant me understanding
When I am ignorant, grant me knowledge
When I am wandering, grant me counsel
When I am afraid, grant me fortitude
When I am separated from you, grant me piety
When I am selfish, grant me the fear of the Lord.
I ask for an outpouring of your Spirit with all of these gifts in your name. Amen
