Today's Gospel

Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?



Have you ever felt like this? Have you ever felt like you were sinking in a raging sea, and no matter how hard you prayed, and how intently you looked for Jesus, Jesus just didn't seem to be listening? Did you ever feel like you would hit the bottom of the sea before Jesus ever got around to doing anything about it? Have you ever asked aloud: Why? Why me? What did I do to deserve this? It can't be said enough: God never, ever, ever promises that nothing bad will ever happen. God never promises smooth sailing and blue skies every day. If you think that God promises this, you haven't read your Bible lately. What God does promise is that when the world comes crashing down, God is right there with us. Jesus is there with us, in the sinking boat. This is an important part of the story: Jesus isn't elsewhere. He is in the boat with the disciples. Sinking. And then he calms the storm. So, maybe the world is crashing in on you today. Maybe it was yesterday. And then again, maybe it will be tomorrow. But, whenever it does – and it's not a matter of 'if,' but 'when' – whatever you think, and whatever your prayer, know that you haven't been abandoned. God is with you. And all you need is enough faith to get you through to the moment when Jesus speaks, 'Peace. Be still.'
