Pastor's Ponderings

I've always loved the poetry of Patrick Kavanagh, the Monaghan born poet. His writing is earthy and rooted in the landscape of his childhood. His poem "Advent" begins with a reflection on the loss of a sense of wonder..."we have tested and tasted too much, lover, Through a chink too wide there comes in no wonder" ...but then Kavanagh says that Advent is a time for a recovery of a sense of wonder "the dry black bread and sugarless tea of penance will charm back the luxury of a child's soul". And as we approach the great feast of Christmas, it is time for us, once again, "to charm back the luxury of a child's soul". Children have a sense of wonder and awe very naturally. They delight in blowing bubbles, they can chase after a butterfly or be intrigued with a ladybird. Surely, Christmas is a time for recovering that sense of wonder...for allowing ourselves to go beyond all that is scientific, all that is material and all that is tangible. Real magic and real wonder happen when we open our souls and our hearts to things that move us. A beautiful piece of music enables us to transcend ourselves. The perfection of a baby can make us wonder about a creator God. The dignity of people who encounter great struggles and, yet, have a sense of joy and life, makes us reflect on human resilience. These are moments for wonder in our lives. So, my wish for all of us, as Advent concludes and as Christmas unfolds, is that you and I permit ourselves to be people who wonder...to look into a crib and see the wonder of a God who comes to us as a tiny vulnerable baby. And then, in the words of Kavanagh, "Christ comes with a January flower". (Fr. George Hayes)
