Annuntio vobis gaudium magnum....Habemus Papam. I bring you news of great joy...we have a Pope. The Latin formula used by Cardinal Mamberti, to announce to the world, on Thursday evening, that we have a new Pope, contains the same words that we read in the Gospel of Luke on Christmas Eve, when the angels appeared to the shepherds in the field...

*I bring you news of great joy.....* Aren't our hearts filled with joy? We have witnessed another moment of enormous significance - after Pope Francis, we have Pope Leo. And Pope Leo began his ministry as successor of Peter with these words of the Risen Lord, "*Peace be with you*". Robert Prevost becomes Pope Leo XIV. Pope Leo has wonderful human qualities: kind, gentle, calm. He is a man of prayer, steeped in the tradition of St. Augustine. He loved maths and has a great talent for languages. He left America to preach the Gospel in Peru, living among the poor and disadvantaged.
