It was a perfect location for a secret Mass as there was an escape route across the Cleady River to get the priest away safely in the event of a raid.

We will meet at Holy Cross Church at 7pm and walk to Poll an Aifrin, arriving for Mass at about 8pm. It is an opportunity to remember all those who worshipped in this place and to share in the tradition of community pilgrimages.
