The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica represents a pivotal moment in Christian history, symbolizing the establishment of a central place of worship and governance for the Catholic church. The Church of St John on the Lateran in Rome is 'Mother and Head of all the churches of the City and the World.' It is the cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome (the Pope), and was called 'St John' after the two monasteries once attached, dedicated to St John the Divine and St John the Baptist. It is, however, dedicated to the Most Holy Saviour. Today's feast serves as a reminder of the Church's roots and its ongoing mission in the world.



November mass, in memory of all those whose funerals took place in Kenmare Parish since last year's remembrance mass in November, will take place on Friday 21st November at 7.30pm. Everyone is invited to attend especially if you wish to remember a loved one, neighbour or friend. We will be in contact with the families of the deceased regarding the November 21st mass.

How to help children honour the dead in the month of November
