3. For safety, lit candles will only be permitted within the sanctuary.
4. Confetti is not permitted in the church or its grounds.
5. You will provide all forms and supporting documentation as requested in a timely manner to allow for office processing.
6. Any decorations within the church will be removed at the end of the service unless you wish to donate floral arrangements for the sanctuary.
7. Specific requests will be considered on an individual basis but you agree to the final decision of the Parish Priest in Kenmare.
